


## HMD LECTURE: Thursday, February 27, 2014 Alzheimer's Disease/Dementia Presented by Edward Thrall

There will be a discussion about the statistics—more specifically Alzheimer's, because it's the most prevalent cause of dementia. Statistics will include a breakdown by states within the U.S. and statistics by country. Possible causes of dementia and current research and treatments for dementia will be discussed. Included will be some personal stories about the lecturer's experience with his mother, her journey with Alzheimer's, and the spiritual aspects of that experience.
